# Shopping Bus



No need to shop alone or struggle to get to the shops, join us **every other Tuesday** on the Shopping Bus to Sainsbury's and Tesco.

Our Shopping Bus will collect you from your home, take you shopping with the wonderful assistance of our volunteers who can also help carry your shopping. You will then be dropped back to your home and our volunteers can help get your shopping inside if needed.

The Shopping Bus goes to Sainsbury's on West Wickham High Street in the mornings, where you are collected between 9-10am and dropped home between 11am-12pm. We go to Tesco in Elmers End in the afternoons where you are collected between 12-1pm and dropped home between 3-4pm. During the visit to Tesco we spend time in the Costa Coffee located in the store to enjoy a hot drink, cake and a good chat!



The trip is £7 per person and we will call you the day before to confirm if you would like to come to either Sainsbury's or Tesco. If you would like to join the clients already part of this service then please call our office on 0208 662 9599

## Medical Drives

Our lovely team of volunteer drivers allow us to provide a service where we can drive you to your local medical appointments and return you home if required. We ask that clients contribute a cash donation for the drive with the recommended amounts:

- £6 for a local return journey in Shirley/WW
- £6 each way for drives to Croydon, Beckenham or Purley
- £7 each way for the PRUH
- £8 each way for Orpington Hospital

If you require a medical drive, please call our office and if possible, provide at least a week's notice to allow us time to book a driver. If you are a blue badge holder, please bring this along on your drive. Please note that any parking charges are to be paid by the client.

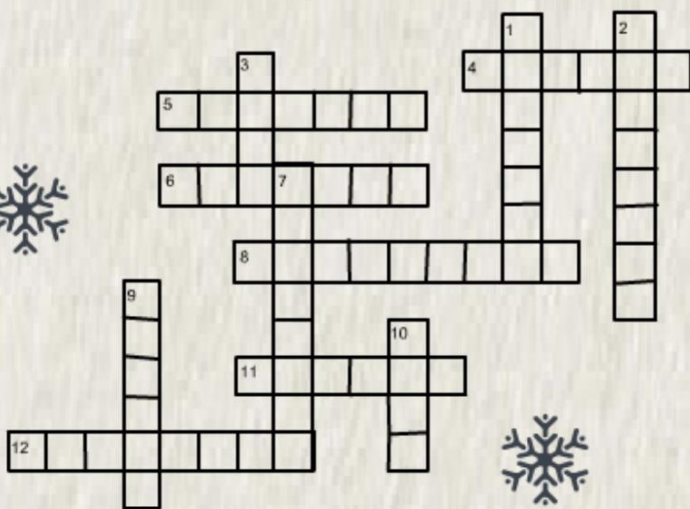
## CENTRE TRIP – Christmas shopping in store

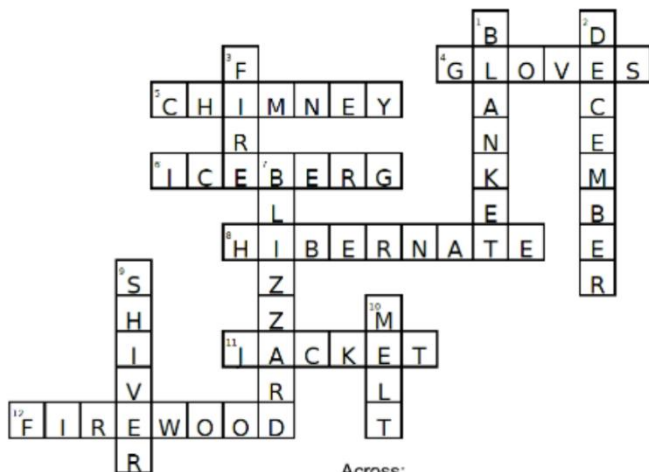
